

# Coding NJ Integrated Care for Kids (NJ InCK) for Primary Care

*For licensed physicians, licensed PAs, licensed midwives, licensed APNs*

## NJ InCK General Information

<b>Purpose</b>	NJ InCK is a program designed to support children with Medicaid who may have medical and social health care needs by helping families find and access community-based resources.
<b>Who Qualifies?</b>	Monmouth & Ocean county residents enrolled in NJ FamilyCare (Medicaid and CHIP under plans ABP, A, B, C and D) ages birth through 20.
<b>Resource Help</b>	Food pantries, utility services, housing assistance, school-based services, legal services and more.
<b>Benefits</b>	Direct point of contact assistance and support, updates to the child's primary care provider of child's needs.
<b>Care Team</b>	Care Resource Navigator, Licensed Social Worker, Community Health Worker, Child Life Specialist, Family Support Specialist.

## How to refer to NJ InCK?

- Scan or ask the family to scan the QR Code and complete the NJ InCK Interest Form (*only takes 1-2 minutes mainly asking demographic information*).
- Visit the NJ InCK website, [www.njinck.org](http://www.njinck.org), and complete the NJ InCK Interest Form.
- You may complete the Interest Form on behalf of a child post consent.

## Before the primary care visit

Beneficiaries must complete the NJ InCK Needs Assessment (HealthStory) and receive a Service Integration Level (SIL) 1, 2 or 3 depending on their risk. The HealthStory is sent to the child's provider/practice through a secure email. Child's provider downloads the HealthStory and saves it to review during the child's next primary care visit in the office (*attach in child's chart/print*).

## Billing and Coding Guidelines

Who	Task
Child's provider	Discusses the HealthStory report with the patient and family during the office visit <i>i.e. patient's annual well-visit (99381-99385, 993391-99395) or an E&amp;M visit (99201-99205, 99211-99215)</i> . This service cannot be billed independently.
Child's provider	Documents actions to address identified medical, behavioral, and social needs in the patient's medical record. If provider identifies lower or higher risk, they can request to change the Service Integration Level (SIL) the child originally received.
Child's provider / Billing department	Bill to fee-for-service and managed care using the following codes below to get an additional \$35 per patient per year:
<b>G9920 + 33 modifier</b>	<b>Interpretation of NJ InCK HealthStory for Beneficiary assigned to SIL 1.</b>
<b>G9919 + 33 modifier</b>	<b>Interpretation of NJ InCK HealthStory for Beneficiary assigned to SIL 2 or 3*: <i>PLEASE NOTE: You can bill every 6 months for those beneficiaries: 1) younger than 36 months or 2) assigned to SIL 3.</i></b>

## Notes

Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC) may submit claims for this service. However, the provision of the service will not affect the bundled rates paid to FQHCs for office visits under the prospective payment system (PPS).
